Penetrating heel injury mimicking cracked plantar hyperkeratosis.

Abstract

The case reported here discusses hyperkeratosis and its presentation, which often results in painful cracking and fissures around the foot. In this case the hyperkeratosis mimicked penetrating foot trauma caused by blackthorn. The treatment consisted of thorn removal - all show in the film. The patient was also referred for further help regarding hyperkeratosis.

Streszczenie

W opisywanym przypadku omówiono hiperkeratozę i jej przebieg, która często skutkuje bolesnym pękaniem i szczelinami wokół stopy. Pacjent został również skierowany dalej w celu leczenia hiperkeratozy.
